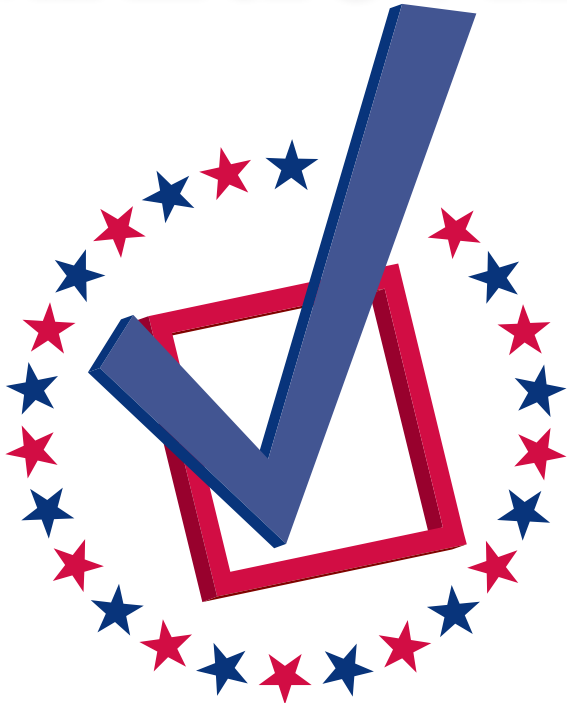

Clearly, the Marysville Exempted Village School District (MEVSD) has not been able to maintain the services and academic programs they offered one year ago. The district did not want to reduce services and programs, but had to. They wanted to maintain the programs and services that were in place in 2007, but couldn't.

Those services and programs helped make the school district an Excellent District, as awarded by the Ohio Department of Education, in 3 out of the last 5 years. But the lack of state funding, state tax code changes and enrollment growth without any additional local funding caused the district to reduce services and programs.

The reductions made by the district thus far have been difficult but the MEVSD is mandated by the state to maintain a balanced budget. What the district offers in a year from now and beyond is in the hands of the community on November 4th.

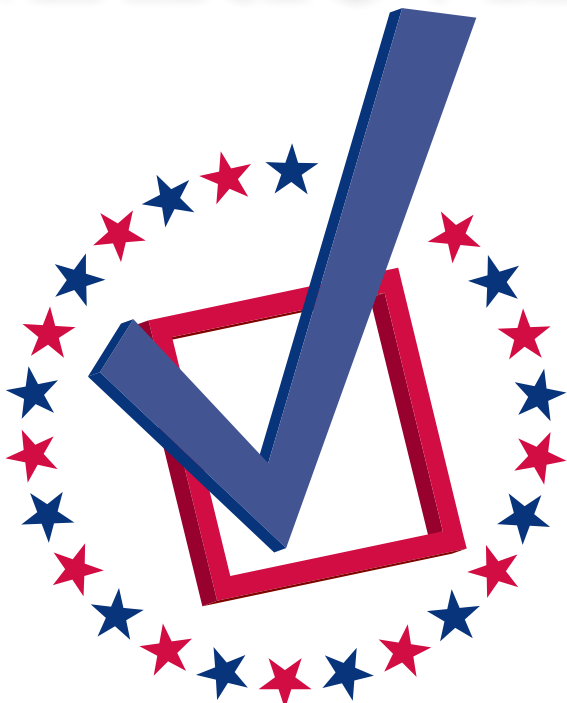
